

Bicycle, Scooter, Skateboard and Rollerblades Policy

- 1. The Department of Education and Training and NSW Roads and Traffic Authority recommends that children under 10 years of age DO NOT ride bicycles, scooters, skateboards or rollerblades to or from school unless accompanied by an adult.
- 2. Children must correctly wear a Standards Australia approved helmet at all times when in control of these forms of transport.
- 3. All RTA road rules concerning bicycles are to be followed. This includes the pedestrians' right of way on footpaths when on a bicycle or scooter. The bicycle bell should be used as a warning when approaching pedestrians and cyclists must dismount from their bicycles to give pedestrians the right of way.
- 4. All forms of transport ridden to school must be in good, safe working order and bicycles must be fitted with a bell.
- 5. Children are to dismount before entering the school grounds and walk their transport whilst on site.
- Bicycles/scooters are to be stored in the bike rack provided behind the library. Bicycles/scooters must be locked with a chain and padlock supplied by the bicycle/scooter owner. Rollerblades and skateboards are stored as directed by the class teacher.
- 7. Bicycles, scooters, skateboards, rollerblades and helmets are brought and stored on site at the owner's risk.
- 8. Parents will be notified if children do not adhere to the *School's Policy*. Students may be refused entry with their bicycles, scooters, skateboards or rollerblades to the school grounds.
- 9. No riding of bicycles, scooters, skateboards or rollerblades is permitted in school grounds.
