

## WHO TO CONTACT

If you have a question about	Who to contact
Student Learning	Please contact your child's classroom teacher. This may be via a phone call to the office, a written note or Class Dojo.
Your child's welfare	Please contact your child's classroom teacher. This may be via a phone call to the office, a written note or Class Dojo.
The actions of a child towards my child when at school	Contact the front office and they will put you in contact with the appropriate staff member.
The actions of a child towards my child when travelling to or from school	Contact the front office and they will put you in contact with the appropriate executive staff member.
Playground incidents	Contact the office and they will put you in contact with the relevant Assistant Principal who attended to the incident.
Actions of a parent while on school grounds	Contact the front office and they will put you in contact with the appropriate executive staff member.
Actions of a staff member	Discuss with staff member. Contact stage supervisor for the relevant staff member. Discuss with School Principal.
Reflection Room	If you have a question regarding your child being sent to the Reflection Room, please contact the Assistant Principal for your child's stage.
Lost Property	Lost property is kept inside the school office and can be accessed before or after school.
Sports events or PSSA	Contact the school office and they will be able to put you in contact with the relevant staff member for each specific sporting event or PSSA team.
Extracurricular activities	Contact the front office and they will put you in contact with the relevant staff member.
High School	Contact the Stage 3 Assistant Principal
Financial Assistance	If you require financial assistance, please contact the school office.
A school policy or practice	Please contact the office and the appropriate member of staff will respond.
School excursions and events	The front office is able to answer questions and queries regarding these events. Alternatively, they may put you in contact with the organiser for specific activities.
P&C questions and events	The School P &C committee meet on the third Tuesday evening of each month in the library at 7pm. All parents and carers are welcome to attend. Alternatively, you can access the school's P&C Facebook page for information or call the front office to leave a message for one of the P&C members.
